

## **Satisfaction Survey- Results**

Following three previous scientific ERN-EYE workshops devoted to ontology, to genetic testing and to novel therapies, ERN-EYE has organized a fourth scientific workshop on “Eye Modelling” from 25th to 26th November in Dublin, Ireland.

After nearly 2 years of 100% remote events, this meeting took place in a hybrid format and gathered nearly 90 people, remotely or on site. These included the full members of ERN-EYE, the affiliated members and the future members of the network, ePAG members as well as prestigious invited international speakers.


**35 people answered the survey, representing a little less of half of the participants at the meeting. 16 of them were on site in Dublin, 19 were online.**

It was the first time that an ERN-EYE meeting was organised in hybrid form, online and on site. It was a big technical challenge, but in view of the 35 answers of the satisfaction survey, it seems that this meeting met the expectations of the participants and that they were happy to have the choice to participate on site or online.

The meeting was organised on Zoom, which is a tool that seems to satisfy the participants.


The results are presented below, question by question, with the percentages of responses.

Total votes : 35


## The duration of the meeting was



Total votes : 35


We noted that the participants were generally satisfied with the progress and organisation of the meeting. This time, the duration seemed to be good, a little too long for one of them.

Total votes : 35


## The venue and its location met my expectations



Total votes : 35


The registration was efficient for the participants. People who attended on site found the place of the meeting very good.

Total votes : 35


## The chat solution (slido) was good



Total votes : 35


