WORKSHOP FOCUS

During this interactive video-based session, we will explore challenging clinical strabismus cases encountered in daily practice. We will discuss indications for surgical treatment, selection of appropriate techniques, and the decision-making process regarding whether surgery is necessary. The session will also include analysis of postoperative outcomes and exploration of factors that may contribute to unexpected results.

In addition, we will share practical surgical experience from strabismus operations performed at CCUH on August 13, 2025, both with and without the use of Tutopach (bovine pericardium).
